Pilot Project:

Quality Education Foundation conducted a pilot on the English Conversation Skills Development for 100 children of Paritewadi School. The contents and innovative use of technology has been successful in showing the improvement in English speaking skills of these children. This has surely given the confidence to the organization that if worked in this direction in more structured manner then then it can turn out effective to larger set of children. Hence this pilot is considered as the basis for this proposed project.

Area Profile



Material/curriculum to be used as part of project delivery

English: Regional **English Language** Office (RELO). The curriculum developed by US Council India was used. The resources from this library were leveraged to design the curriculum for SAKSHAM.

Mathematics: A set of activities and action sheets prepared by a group of selected experts such as the subject matter experts from the Quality Education Foundation. District Institute of **Education and Training** (DIET)Solapur and subject teachers in the respective schools

Teachers Training to become SAKSHAM Facilitators: The teachers were be trained on the session curriculum as well as process of carrying out tracking and monitoring of students outside session activities.

Project delivery Methodology

The program was implemented with the help of government agencies with a view to rehabilitate the disrupted education system during the Corona period and continuing education for all students.











Let's Cross the Borders

To stand for peace

























Global Peace Index has revealed shocking truth. Countries like India-Pakistan, Iraq-Iran, Israel-Palestine have spent around \$ 124 million to engage in conflict. If the countries can afford to pay this much for conflict, peace is way cheaper. Coming from a family of teachers, peace is a concept of Ranjitsinh Disale, a 33-year-old primary school teacher from Solapur, imbibed early on in life. SDG-16, which is to be achieved by 2030, focuses on creating peaceful, justiciable, and strong institutions in the world. It is an important goal in the context of making this world more peaceful. Focusing on peaceful leadership, Ranjitsinh Disale has designed a project named-'Let's Cross the Borders'. It carries out in three phases. Initially, it was carried out in two schools. ZP school Paritewadi exchanged ideas with students from Roots International School in Islamabad. As word started spreading within the teaching community, schools from other cities and States also started participating.

We conduct this program every year between August and September, where we focus on bringing students together to engage in peaceful conversations. Phase one is all about selection process where we invite entries from teachers, school leaders those who are interested to create peaceful environment in their classroom.


Second phase lasts for 6 week. In the first week, the students are allotted a peace buddy from the other country, with whom they interact and get to know each other. Over the next two weeks, the students prepare presentations on why the two countries are fighting, and similarities and differences between the two. While the fourth week involves reading a chapter from the autobiography of Microsoft CEO Satya Nadella. Fifth week has lectures by speakers from the top 10 peaceful countries as per the UN. In the concluding session, the students have to give a commitment as to how they will become peaceful citizens of the world. While the project can be tailored to suit countries and context, it aims at creating an army of peace soldiers. Students from two nations that are at loggerheads will only interact with each other. For instance, keeping in mind the relations between India and Pakistan, students from the two countries interact with each other. So far, we have been able to form a peace army of 18,000 students from eight countries. It is heart-warming to see little students champion the cause of peace, something that seniors must do. Early in March 2019 our courses were put to test when India and Pakistan were on the verge of war following the Pulwama terror attack. We distributed a form among students to understand what they felt about the two countries. We also encouraged them to read newspapers of the neighbouring country. We realised the students were very positive about their peace buddies, though there was heated talk on the political front. Nurturing peaceful citizens across the globe, has become important than ever before. There is a lot of jingoism and excitement when situations become tense. Peace is not just important when war looms over two countries. Peace is when your fallen wallet remains on the street untouched, when you forget to lock your door, but can still rest assured. And inculcating this at a young age will prove to be beneficial for the future.

In a third phase, students share their learning with rest of the students. They do promote peaceful activities in a society. Based on their commitment and performance, teacher do select a colonel of the peace army.

Introduction:

Global Peace Index 2016 - which ranks countries according to their level of peace, revealed shocking truth. Only 10 countries in the world are peaceful. We all are familiar with Indo-Pak, Israel-Palestine conflicts. World has faced two wars and still we are fighting against each other. THE WORLD HAS BECOME LESS PEACEFUL EVERY YEAR SINCE 2008. We need to promote peace to create the world of tomorrow. Leaders of future -who are in the classroom today, can play vital role to stand for peace. Peace is a positive, achievable and tangible measure of human well-being and progress. SDG-16 advocates promotion of peaceful and inclusive societies. SDG 16 is the most ambitious goal and faces unique practical challenges in its implementation.



















Connect, Share and Learn

Research shows that the quality of teachers is a major determinant of children's learning and well-being. Going from a poor-performing teacher to a great teacher can increase student learning by multiple years of schooling. Great teachers also have a substantial impact on the well-being of students throughout their lives, affecting not only their academic achievement, but also other long-term social and labour outcomes.

Connect, Share and Learn is a tailor made program specially designed to widen horizon of Government school teacher by connecting them with World's Best Teachers. Carried out for 13 weeks during the pandemic, it has helped them to understand new trends in education.












Green Planet






Green Planet is a project started with an aim to "protect restore and promote sustainable use of territorial eco systems, sustainably manage forests, combat desertification and halt and reverse land degradation and halt biodiversity loss."

This project is under SDG14 and involves the use of technology for environment protection. This projected was awarded by the National Geographic Society for innovative use of technology for environment protection.



How do we execute???





The project is a 5 year plan that uses sensors to map areas for tree plantation. His school being in a drought prone district he realized the need to map areas where trees can be planted. Through this project the green area in Paritewadi district has increased from 25 to 33% and 250 hectares of land surrounding the village has been saved from desertification. As part of the project the students make environmental report cards of their villages/towns/cities to understand the ripple effect of global warming. They also interact with experts to find solutions for the problems they identify.

The Green Planet project was awarded the Wipro Nature for Society award in 2019.







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
